Nargol port to be developed as a Greenfield port with an extended BOOT period of 50 years

Shri Vijay Rupani, Chief Minister, Gujarat has approved development of a Greenfield port at Nargol located in South Gujarat through Public Private Partnership (PPP) with an extended BOOT period of 50 years.

In deference to the fact that port projects have huge gestation lags, Government of Gujarat is setting a precedent by keeping the initial BOOT period for Nargol port development at 50 years, rather than the 30 years usually offered for Greenfield port development in Gujarat.

This initiative presents the potential port developer with an assurance for greater Return on Investment.

In the present economic scenario, this is also a shot in the arm for the developer.

The proposal also offers the interested developers the flexibility to quote discounted waterfront royalty rate in addition to the prevailing system of quoting premium on the base rates.

The Nargol port developer would be selected through a global bidding process that would be transparent, robust and flexible.

The major port of JNPT in Mumbai is expected to exhaust its present container handling capacity of 10 million by 2025. This presents Gujarat with an opportunity to have a Greenfield port in South Gujarat to cater to the EXIM and coastal trade requirements of the sound industrial base in the hinterland comprising of the entire area of South Gujarat, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh.

Considering the strategic location of Nargol and its proximity to the Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) and the Delhi Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC), the port is estimated to handle sizable traffic of containers, dry bulk and liquid bulk cargo.

The primary hinterland of Nargol is marked by a significant presence of chemical companies and textile units with major players like Atul Limited, Aarti Industries Limited, Pidilite Industries Limited, United Phosphorus Ltd, Welspun Polyesters India Ltd., etc. operating in the region. Vapi and Pardi are the two major industrialised centres in Valsad district. Paper and sugar mills in the hinterland further present the opportunity to handle additional EXIM traffic.

Development of Nargol port in the vicinity of these centres is likely to spur the growth in EXIM and coastal cargo movement and will also promote investments by new companies in view of an already well developed industrial infrastructure in the region.

Located approximately 140 km north of Mumbai and 120km south of Surat, Nargol is envisaged to be a multi-functional port capable of managing solid, liquid, and container cargo with an estimated investment of INR 3800 crore in the first phase. The developer would have the freedom and flexibility of expansion of the port pro-



ject after completion of the first phase. Three berths are envisaged for development in the first phase to handle containers and other cargo including coal, fertilizers and chemicals. The initial phase will witness capacity addition of close to 40 million tonnes.

The location of the port alongside the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC) and Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) would further benefit the development of the port in the long run, given the fact

that 38% of the catchment area of DFC falls in Gujarat and, 62% of the total area in Gujarat would be under the influence of DMIC. This would necessitate creation of additional port facilities to cater to the demand arising out of the development of these projects.

With the expected completion of these ambitious projects, Gujarat's current share of 40% in the total national throughput is envisioned to go up substantially.

Sub: Clearance of Bills of Entries on odd hours- reg.

- **1.** Attention is invited to the Board's Circular No 40/2020-Customs dated 04.09.2020 and Public Notice issued by Jamnagar Commissionerate i.e. Public Notice No.09/CCP/JMR/2020 dated 16.09.2020 in accordance to which Faceless Assessment has been rolled out in all ports of import and for all imported goods from 31.10.2020.
- 2. In this connection, reference is also invited to Para 5.7 of Guidebook for FacelessAssessment published in the CBIC's Portal (Customs-Manuals-Guidebook for Faceless Assessment) wherein all Saturdays (except second Saturdays) have been made working days for all FAGs.
- **3.** In has been pointed out that some faceless assessments have been done in odd hours by officers of Port Commissionerate. The Chairman, CBIC has instructed as below:
- "Working at odd hours should be done only if absolutely necessary and with the approval of the Commissioner. Control Room should monitor the entry and exit of Officers/staff at the Custom House and especially the Appraising Hall or any other place where assessing Officers have their office from 10 pm to 8 am, and put up to the AC(PG) for necessary action."
- **4.** As the normal working hours is from 9.30 am to 6.00 pm, it is hereby instructed that assessing officers shall work only during 9.30 am to 6.00 pm in normal circumstances. However, if there is pendency of Bill of Entry/ Shipping Bills in the officers menu for assessment, the officer may work upto 8.00 pm. The work relating to out of charge/LEO commences only after assessment and payment of duty/tax if any, hence officers assigned out of charge/LEO related roles, may attend work upto 9.00pm. In case of any emergency and urgent work even after 9.00pm, same should be attended atleast after oral permission of the supervisory Addl./Joint Commissioner as the case may be, such verbal permission should be converted in written confirmation at earliest. Also with regard to roaster duty allotted by the co-convenors of a particular FAG for holidays; thesame should be attended to during 9.30 am to 6.00 pm.
- **5.** The Addl./Joint Commissioners are directed to strictly monitor and keep a watch on odd hours assessments and bring it to the notice of the Pr. Commissioner if any such instance is noticed.

Gujarat unveils its first Integrated Logistics and Logistics Park policy, CM accords IPA

Only after 2 days of releasing the EV policy, Chief Minister of Gujarat accorded 'In-principal approval' to state's first 'Integrated Logistics and Logistics Park policy'.

Believed to be one of its kind policy, focusing on integrated logistics development and covering the entire value chain, the policy is expected to enhance Gujarat's industrial competitiveness manifold and create employment opportunities for the youth. The policy provides support to all logistics facilities like logistics parks, warehouses, cold storage, air freight stations, jetties, ports, etc.

The policy is aligned with the draft National Logistics policy (NLP), which focuses on driving the country's economic and trade competitiveness through integrated, seamless, efficient, reliable and cost effective logistics network by leveraging technology, innovation and skill enhancement, stated in a press release given by Govt. of Gujarat.

The global supply chain changed significantly last year because of the pandemic and many companies are shifting their operations in India. The state has seen an increase in investment especially in the manufacturing sector. The policy's timing is thus fitting. A robust network of logistics will give a competitive advantage to the state which will help attract more investment and support businesses grow.

It is worth mentioning that Gujarat ranked no. 1 in the Logistics Ease Across Different States (LEADS) Index instituted by Ministry of Commerce & Industry (MoC&I) both in 2018 and 2019. The index benchmarks logistics performance across the states. Some of the evaluation parameters of the LEADS index 2019 included availability and quality of logistics infrastructure, ease of track and trace, quality of logistics services, timeliness of cargo delivery, state facilitation and coordination, efficiency of regulatory processes, etc., release mentioned.

Infrastructure enhancement projects:

Gujarat is a forward looking state and the government understands that logistics is the backbone of its manufacturing sector. As such, many futuristic projects are already underway, which includes 1. Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) will pass through Gujarat with around 560 kms length, along which freight logistics parks have been planned to enhance rail-based traffic, carrying investment of about INR 7,000 crore; 2. The Ahmedabad Dholera Expressway which is 110-kilometre long and six-lane expressway is also under construction; 3 Expressway will connect Dholera Special Investment Region (SIR) and proposed Dholera International Airport with Ahmedabad; 4 Development of around 11 jetties and various ports have been planned; 5 Around 7 rail connectivity projects have been proposed for providing connectivity to industrial areas including a) rail line connectivity to Hazira port and industries in the Hazira area to DFC, b) Gauge conversion project is being undertaken on Katosan- Becharaji- Chanasma-Ranauj line, c) rail line projects to provide first and last mile connectivity to ports such as New Bedi & Rozi, Nargol, etc. have already been envisaged by the state government.

Gujarat's logistics policy was prepared after an in-depth analysis of cargo movement data, review of draft national logistics policy, benchmarking study of policies of other states covering one or more areas of logistics and detailed discussions with government and private stakeholders to identify objectives and support areas. **Incentives mechanism:**

As such, specific incentives and support mechanisms have been identified under this policy to promote private sector investment and make the logistics network more efficient. For example, capital subsidy to the tune of 25% of the eligible fixed capital investment (EFCI) shall be provided for construction of logistics facilities and development & mechanization of new jetties with a cap of INR 15 crore. Interest subsidy at 7% for 7 years on eligible loan term will be extended with a cap of INR 50 lakh per annum. To bring down the capital cost, the government will also reimburse 100% stamp duty, a release indicated.

Employment Generation & Training:

Such thrust to infrastructure development needs to be complemented by skilled manpower. The policy focuses on skill enhancement which will improve the employability of our youth. Up to INR 15,000 per trainee for more than 120 hours of training will

be reimbursed. In case of women trainees, 100% fees will be reimbursed with the intention of increasing their participation in this sector. Other assistance related to quality certification, patent, R&D will also be provided under this policy.

Focus on Technology & Quality:

Another salient feature of the policy is its focus on technology and quality enhancement of logistic services. Specific support will be given to private companies to adopt disruptive technologies to increase their efficiency and visibility across the value chain including improved tracking of cargo. This will improve the quality of services and will benefit the end user immensely. Greater efficiency in the logistics network will also reduce the overall cost for the end user.

Officials also mentioned that transport is looked as a key contributor to CO2 emissions. Any policy should thus focus on decarbonizing this sector. Gujarat's Integrated Logistics and Logistics Park policy addresses this concern by extending support to R&D and innovation to make this sector sustainable and environment friendly.

Integrated Approach:

A statewide logistics masterplan will be developed as part of this policy which will study the utilization of the existing infrastructure and accordingly identify strategic locations for new projects across the state. This will be done through rigorous coordination with over 10 government departments and agencies such as Ports & Transport department, Roads & Buildings department, GUJSAIL, G-Ride, GIDC, GMB, etc.

Considering it a game changer, it is learnt that a separate team of experts will be constituted to implement the objectives of this policy and promote its widespread adoption. These experts will also coordinate with private players and trade associations to identify new initiatives that can be undertaken to make Gujarat a leader in the logistics sector.

With the Agility deal, DSV Panalpina will set to Top among global Freight Forwarders

Assuming its proposed takeover of Agility GIL is completed, DSV Panalpina will become the world's largest freight forwarder in terms of air and ocean revenues.

According to the Global Freight Forwarding Market 2021 of Transport Intelligence, Kuehne + Nagel (KN) is the current market leader, with combined revenues of €11.5bn, followed by DHL Global Forwarding, with €10.9bn. DSV Panalpina is ranked third, with a revenue of €9.9bn, and Agility 12th, with €2.8bn.

The report says: "With the deal set to be completed in the second half of 2021, the stage is set for changes at the top of the ranking. "GIL's €2.8bn revenues would see DSV Panalpina displace both KN and DHL GF."

It adds that this would be despite a difficult 2020 for the newly merged DSV-Panalpina, which was undergoing the integration of the two firms.

"The final quarter of 2020 was the first with the full impact of the Panalpina acquisition

seen in comparative figures, and it shows the new company is smaller than the individual entities of DSV and Panalpina combined.

The loss of a major customer, scaling back of Panalpina's perishables business and discontinuation of other activities were noted as reasons for air volumes falling a staggering 26% year on year in Q4, well below market performance.

DSV Panalpina-Agility is also expected to become the market share leader, according to analysed information. It shows current leader KN's market share of 7.3% would be superseded by the combination of DSV-Panalpina's 6.3% and Agility's 1.7% market share.

In a separate development, following the migration of the Damco brand last year to its parent company as part of Maersk's integrator push, Maersk Logistics & Services now finds itself as the world's 18th-largest air freight forwarder, with annual revenue of €663m and a market share of 0.7%.

GCCI, GDMA organized a webinar on "Direct Export by Rail from ICD Khodiyar to Bangladesh"

CONCOR speaks on present services available, procedure, tariff, benefits, etc.

Gujarat Chamber of Commerce & Industry (GCCI) and Gujarat Dyestuff Manufacturers Association (GDMA) organized a webinar for their members to create awareness of land movement by Rail to Bangladesh from ICD Khodiyar.





The webinar was conducted on 23rd June, wherein 100+ members participated to understand the customs cleared export shipment by Rail to Bangladesh from their hometown.

In a welcome address. Mr. Natubhai Patel, President, GDMA cited that "Bangladesh is one of the rising countries, in not only in Asia but in the world today, being a young country only 50 years, remarkable progress in sustainable economic growth has happened in last decade. Readymade garment and frozen sea food have attracted lot many countries to import from Bangladesh. The trade between two countries India and Bangladesh is approx. USD 10.0bn. including exports worth USD 8.50 bn with various products which includes Cotton bales, rice, sugar, machinery, organic chemical, pharma, plastic, leather etc. India is also importing worth USA 1.3 bn in return, mainly edible oil, garments made-ups, Hydrogen peroxide, caustic live etc. because energy cost is almost 50% that of in Indian. Bangladesh is important for the exports of Dyestuff material, pharma, rice, plastic granules from Gujarat, Sugar from Maharashtra and organic chemicals from both the states."

He emphasized on Railroad movement to reduce the logistics cost, improve speedy delivery and to avoid the Chittagong boarder hurdles and welcomed CONCOR dignitaries to inform about exports through Rail to their members for win-win situation.

Rameshbhai Patel, President, GCCI welcomed members of GDMA, GCCI and introduced CONCOR officials.

Container Corporation of India Ltd (CONCOR)'s senior officers Mr. A. Vaasudeva Rao, Executive Director,





Head-Area-II (West) of CON-COR, Mr. Alok Badkul, Executive Director, Head Area-IV (East) and Mr. Madhukar Roat, CGM/Ahmedabad Cluster spoke about present rail movement by CONCOR to Bangladesh, procedures for exports from ICDs, tariff, benefits to trade, role of each stakeholder, potential, challenges and its ambitions, etc.

Mr. Madhukar Roat explained about CONCOR's first train movement from Gujarat, moved with chemical cargo of M/s. Prakash Chemicals International Pvt Ltd loaded in CONCOR owned containers from ICD Ankleshwar on 11th this month. The containers were cleared from Customs at ICD Ankleshwar itself and the train moved to Majerhat Terminal of CONCOR at Kolkata for further movement to Benapole.

CONCOR has 20 ft Side Access (SA) containers from which cargo can be directly offloaded at Benapole while on wagon only. Mr. Roat explained its benefit of movement by rail – clearance & documentation at ICD Ahmedabad, Sealed with eseal 'ECTS' by CBIC, CONCOR's huge inventory of empty containers at ICD, time and cost saving, trace & track system.

He added, the awareness of such movement is less in the Ahmedabad market and, therefore, he appreciated GCCI and GDMA for organizing such webinar for sharing all the information pertaining



to export to Bangladesh to Benapole.

Mr. Vaasudeve Rao, explained the benefits of movement of export by rail against the export by via Chiatagong port, which is already operating 6-7 times beyond its capacity leading to holding of vessel, containers at CFS, congestion on road-route leading to border waiting time and higher cost.

Mr. Rao explained that India is adopting multi-pronged strategy to enhance trade and business partnership with Bangladesh, when China is strategically trying to woo Dhaka with its duty-free access to its product. He further added that Bangladesh is one of the 10 largest export destinations for India with \$ 9.21 billion. The major export commodity that are moved by CONCOR are Cotton, Vehicles, Minerals, fuels, nuclear reactors, Iron & Steel, cereals, electrical equipment, Plastic articles, etc.

He added that if 10% of road traffic to Bangladesh is diverted in Rail, CONCOR will be able to capture 10 trains load traffic a month. With the growth potential of Bangladesh, return traffic will help further to reduce the logistics cost. He mentioned that CON-COR has suggested various measures to the authorities of Bangladesh, for improvement in the logistics facilities such as One-stop Logistics Park, Interim arrangement with Customs at BBW, Transit terminal developments, modification in SRO, Train accepting capacity, permission for all kinds of wagons, etc.

CONCOR has started Bangladesh movement April 2018 from North to Bangabandhu station Bangladesh and moved around 11 trains with 60 TEUs each train, during the pandemic period. Mr. Alok Badkul clarified the process of movement from their CFS Majerhat in Kolkata to Benapole and potential of exports from Gu-

CONCOR complimented the efforts made by the GCCI and GDMA for creation of this awareness and also appreciated the interest of Gujarat trading community in the business.
