GCCI, GDMA organized a webinar on “Direct Export by Rail from ICD Khodiyar to Bangladesh”

CONCOR speaks on present services available, procedure, tariff, benefits, etc.

Industry (GCCI) and

Gujarat Dyestuff Manufacturers Association (GDMA) organized a webinar for their members to create awareness of land movement by Rail to Bangladesh from ICD Khodiyar.

The webinar was conducted on 23rd June, wherein 100+ members participated to understand the customs cleared export shipment by Rail to Bangladesh from their hometown.

In a welcome address, **Mr. Natubhai Patel, President, GDMA** cited that “Bangladesh is one of the rising countries, in not only in Asia but in the world today, being a young country only 50 years, remarkable progress in sustainable economic growth has happened in last decade. Readymade garment and frozen sea food have attracted lot many countries to import from Bangladesh. The trade between two countries India and Bangladesh is approx. USD 10.0bn. including exports worth USD 8.50 bn with various products which includes Cotton bales, rice, sugar, machinery, organic chemical, pharma, plastic, leather etc. India is also importing worth USA 1.3 bn in return, mainly edible oil,



Prakash Chemicals International Pvt Ltd loaded in CONCOR owned containers from ICD Ankleshwar on 11th this month. The containers were cleared from Customs at ICD Ankleshwar itself and the train moved to Majerhat Terminal of CONCOR at Kolkata for further movement to Benapole.

CONCOR has 20 ft Side Access (SA) containers from which cargo can be directly offloaded at Benapole while on wagon only. Mr. Roat explained its benefit of movement by rail – clearance & documentation at ICD Ahmedabad, Sealed with e-seal ‘ECTS’ by CBIC, CONCOR’s huge inventory of empty containers at ICD, time and cost saving, trace & track system.



garments made-ups, Hydrogen peroxide, caustic live etc, because energy cost is almost 50% that of in Indian. Bangladesh is important for the exports of Dyestuff material, pharma, rice, plastic granules from Gujarat, Sugar from Maharashtra and organic chemicals from both the states.”

He emphasized on Rail-road movement to reduce the logistics cost, improve speedy delivery and to avoid the Chittagong boarder hurdles and welcomed CONCOR dignitaries to inform about exports through Rail to their members for win-win situation.



Rameshbhai Patel, President, GCCI welcomed members of GDMA, GCCI and introduced CONCOR officials.

Container Corporation of India Ltd (CONCOR)’s Senior Officers **Mr. A. Vaasudeva Rao, Executive Director, Head-Area-II (West)** of CONCOR, **Mr. Alok Badkul, Executive Director, Head Area-IV (East)** and **Mr. Madhukar Roat, CGM/Ahmedabad Cluster** spoke about present rail movement by CONCOR to Bangladesh, procedures for exports from ICDs, tariff, benefits to trade, role of each stakeholder, potential, challenges and its ambitions, etc.

Mr. Madhukar Roat explained about CONCOR’s first train movement from Gujarat, moved with chemical cargo of

He added, the awareness of such movement is less in the Ahmedabad market and, therefore, he appreciated GCCI and GDMA for organizing such webinar for sharing all the information pertaining to export to Bangladesh to Benapole.

Mr. Vaasudeve Rao, explained the benefits of movement of export by rail against the export by via Chiatagong port, which is already operating 6-7 times beyond its capacity leading to holding of vessel, containers at CFS, congestion on road-route leading to border waiting time and higher cost.

Mr. Rao explained that India is adopting multi-pronged strategy to enhance trade and business partnership with Bangladesh, when China is strategically trying to woo Dhaka with its duty-free access to its product. He further added that Bangladesh is one of the 10 largest export destinations for India with \$9.21 billion. The major export commodity that are moved by CONCOR are Cotton, Vehicles, Minerals, fuels, nuclear reactors, Iron & Steel, cereals, electrical equipment, Plastic articles, etc.

He added that if 10% of road traffic to Bangladesh is diverted in Rail, CONCOR will be able to capture 10 trains load traffic a month. With the growth potential of Bangladesh, return traffic will help further to reduce the logistics cost. He mentioned that CONCOR has suggested various measures to the authorities of Bangladesh, for improvement in the logistics facilities such as One-stop Logistics Park, Interim arrangement with Customs at BBW, Transit terminal developments, modification in SRO, Train accepting capacity, permission for all kinds of wagons, etc.

CONCOR has started Bangladesh movement in April 2018 from North to Bangabandhu station in Bangladesh and moved around 11 trains with 60 TEUs each train, during the pandemic period. Mr. Alok Badkul clarified the process of movement from their CFS Majerhat in Kolkata to Benapole and potential of exports from Gujarat.

CONCOR complimented the efforts made by the GCCI and GDMA for creation of this awareness and also appreciated the interest of Gujarat trading community in the business.

Mansukh Mandaviya urges States to see Indian Port Bill as a development issue

He further said that the development of the country depends on the development of the states and MSDC is the best example of cooperative federalism. "In a scattered way we can't develop, united we can achieve", the Minister added.

Stressing on the need for the 'Indian Port Bill 2021', the Minister requested state governments to see the Indian Port Bill as a development issue and not as a political issue. He highlighted that the 'Indian Port Bill 2021' will facilitate to have optimum management and utilization of the coastline by way of participation by both the Union Government and Maritime States/Union Territories. He assured the states that the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways will welcome all the suggestions of the states to develop a comprehensive port bill.

The Minister of MoPSW said, "The 18th Maritime State Development Council Meeting today has discussed very significant issues pertaining to the overall progress of the maritime sector. Both Central Government and State Governments will jointly work on the development of the maritime sector including several non-functional ports. Our growth aspiration, as envisioned by our Prime Minister, need collective actions in a time-bound manner and MSDC is an active platform to discuss these matters".

The key items discussed during the meeting are Indian Port bill 2021, National Maritime Heritage Museum (NMHC), Rail and Road connectivity with Ports, Floating Jetties for Marine Operations and Sea Plane Operations, Sagarmala Projects and National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP) projects.

Indian Port Bill 2021: A step towards accelerating India's Port Development

In FY 2020, the traffic handled at Indian ports is about 1.2 billion MT, which is expected to increase to 2.5 billion MT by 2030. On the other hand, only a few ports in India are having deeper draft which can handle capsize vessels. In addition, there are around 100 non-functional ports distributed across the coast of India. The ever-increasing size of ships mandates to have deeper draft ports and indeed mega ports need to be developed. Similarly, the non-functional ports also need to be prioritized and developed.

A national-level integrated approach is required to augment the existing ports or to develop new ports in an efficient and sustainable manner which in turn will reduce the freight costs to a greater extent and improve the trade growth. The national-level integrated port planning is also highlighted in various report including 'The World Bank's Port Reform book, UNCTAD's 'Handbook for Planners in Developing Countries' etc.

MSDC will advise on the planning of all ports including Major Ports. In addition, several conventions pertaining to safety, security and prevention of pollution are incorporated in IP Bill 2021 for implementation of all requirements stipulated in such conventions by all ports.

NMHC – India's first maritime heritage complex

National Maritime Heritage Complex (NMHC) is to be developed as a world-class museum dedicated to the legacy of Maritime Heritage of India, in an area of about 350 acres at Lothal, Gujarat. This maritime heritage complex would be developed as an international tourist destination with a maritime museum, lighthouse museum, maritime theme parks, amusement parks, etc.

One of the key attractions of NMHC is that it would have a pavilion for each coastal states and union territories to showcase the maritime heritage of the specific states and union territories. During the meeting, the coastal states and UTs were requested to take up the development of their respective pavilion.

Enhancing Port Connectivity

The upgradation of port connectivity is one of the critical enablers for ports, and MoPSW through its key initiative Sagarmala Programme emphasizes port connectivity. MoPSW has taken up 98 port-road connectivity projects worth Rs. 45,051 cr. with various implementation agencies like MoRTH, Major Ports, Maritime Boards, and State Road Development Companies, of which 13 projects are completed and 85 projects are in various stages of development and implementation. Similarly, 91 port-rail connectivity projects worth Rs. 75,213 Cr. have been taken up by MoPSW with Indian Railways, Major Ports, and Maritime Boards, of which 28 projects are completed and 63 projects are in various stages of development and implementation.

To address the issues in funding and for the projects that are not suitable to develop under PPP mode, it is suggested that a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) may be formed between state government, central government and private players for which interest from the state governments/UTs is requested during the meeting.



Floating Jetties for Marine Operations & Seaplane Services

Floating jetties are widely used in other countries. The floating jetties have unique advantages in comparison with the convention jetties, like cost-effectiveness, speedy construction, minimal environmental impact, flexibility to expand and relocate, suitable for the locations with high tidal variation etc.

National Technology Centre for Ports, Waterways & Coasts (NTCPWC), IIT Madras was given the mandate to prepare the Detailed Project Report for developing more than 150 floating jetties across Indian Coastline and the work is in progress. It is proposed to utilize the floating jetties majorly for fishing harbours/fish landing centers, and seaplane operations.

The MoPSW informed that the states/UTs are encouraged to explore using floating jetties/platforms for their project and requested states/UTs to identify more locations for developing floating jetties. Projects may be considered for funding from Sagarmala after the due approval of the proposal.

Strengthening Indian Infrastructure through Sagarmala Programme and National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP)

The MoPSW has various infrastructure projects that are undertaken under Sagarmala Programme and National Infrastructure Pipeline (NIP).

The MoPSW proposed to develop 802 projects worth investment of Rs.5.53 lakh crore for implementation under the Sagarmala Programme. Out of which, 168 projects worth Rs. 87,000 crore have been completed and 242 projects worth Rs. 2.18 lakh crore are under implementation. Similarly, MoPSW is handling 123 projects amounting to Rs. 1.28 Lakh cr. under NIP initiated in 2020. In addition, there are 1226 projects under Sagartat Samridhi Yojana for coast led prosperity, out of which 192 projects are under implementation.

The MoPSW requested the coastal states/UTs to expedite the implementation of the projects where the state government is the implementation agency, and funding support can be considered for central funding via grants from MoPSW or via equity funding through Sagarmala Development Company Ltd (SDCL).

Speaking on the occasion, the Minister of MoPSW emphasized the pertinent and urgent need for infrastructure development be it port augmentation, multi-model connectivity through rail/road infrastructure and various project initiatives undertaken through the Sagarmala, National Infrastructure Pipeline, and Sagartat Samridhi Yojana.

The meeting was attended by Shri. Ahmed Devarkoil, Minister of Ports, Kerala, Thiru E.V.Velu, Minister for Public Works, Tamil Nadu, Shri Aslam Sheikh, Minister of Textile, Fisheries and Port Development, Maharashtra, Shri Michael Lobo, Minister for Science and Technology, Waste Management, RDA and Ports, Goa, Shri. Mekapati Goutham Reddy, Minister for Industries, Commerce, Information Technology, Andhra Pradesh, Shri. Padmanabh Behera, Planning & Convergence, Commerce & Transport, Odisha, Admiral D K Joshi (Retd), Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands along with the representatives from the States. The meeting was also attended by representatives and officials from allied Ministries.

MSDC Background: MSDC is an apex advisory body for the development of the Maritime sector and aims to ensure integrated development of Major and non-Major Ports. The MSDC was constituted in May 1997 to assess in consultation with State Governments, the future development of existing and new Minor Ports by the respective Maritime States either directly or through captive users and private participation. Further, MSDC also monitors the development of minor ports, captive ports and private ports in the Maritime States with a view to ensure their integrated development with Major Ports and to assess the requirements of other infrastructure requirements like roads/rail/IWT and make suitable recommendations to the concerned Ministers.

... the policy is expected to enhance Gujarat's industrial competitiveness manifold and create employment opportunities for the youth. The policy provides support to all logistics facilities like logistics parks, warehouses, cold storage, air freight stations, jetties, ports, etc.

The policy is aligned with the draft National Logistics policy which focuses on driving the country's economic and trade competitiveness through integrated, seamless, efficient, reliable and cost effective logistics network by leveraging technology, innovation and skill enhancement.

The global supply chain changed significantly last year because of the pandemic and many companies are shifting their operations in India. The state has seen an increase in investment especially in the manufacturing sector. The policy's timing is thus fitting. A robust network of logistics will give a competitive advantage to the state which will help attract more investment and support businesses grow.

It is worth mentioning that Gujarat ranked no. 1 in the Logistics Ease Across Different States (LEADS) Index instituted by Ministry of Commerce & Industry both in 2018 and 2019. The index benchmarks logistics performance across the states. Some of the evaluation parameters of the LEADS index 2019 included availability and quality of logistics infrastructure, ease of track and trace, quality of logistics services, timeliness of cargo delivery, state facilitation and coordination, efficiency of regulatory processes, etc.

Gujarat is a forward looking state and the government understands that logistics is the backbone of its manufacturing sector. As such, many futuristic projects are already underway. For example, nearly 560 kms of the Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) will pass through Gujarat, along which freight logistics parks have been planned to enhance rail-based traffic. The expected investment in this project in Gujarat alone

is about INR 7,000 crore. The Ahmedabad Dholera Expressway which is 110-kilometre long and six-lane expressway is also under construction. The expressway will connect Dholera Special Investment Region (SIR) and proposed Dholera International Airport with Ahmedabad. Development of around 11 jetties and various ports have been planned. Around 7 rail connectivity projects have been proposed for providing connectivity to industrial areas such as rail line connectivity to Hazira port and industries in the Hazira area to DFC. Existing rail lines are also being enhanced. Gauge conversion project is being undertaken on Katosan- Becharaji- Chanasma- Ranauj line. Other rail line projects to provide first and last mile connectivity to ports such as New Bedi & Rozi, Nargol, etc. have already been envisaged by the state government.

Gujarat's logistics policy was prepared after an in-depth analysis of cargo movement data, review of draft national logistics policy, benchmarking study of policies of other states covering one or more areas of logistics and detailed discussions with government and private stakeholders to identify objectives and support areas.

As such, specific incentives and support mechanisms have been identified under this policy to promote private sector investment and make the logistics network more efficient. For example, capital subsidy to the tune of 25% of the eligible fixed capital investment (EFCD) shall be provided for construction of logistics facilities and development & mechanization of new jetties with a cap of INR 15 crore. Interest subsidy at 7% for 7 years on eligible loan term will be extended with a cap of INR 50 lakh per annum. To bring down the capital cost, the government will also reimburse 100% stamp duty.

Such thrust to infrastructure development needs to be complemented by skilled manpower. The policy focuses on skill enhancement which will improve

the employability of our youth. Up to INR 15,000 per trainee for more than 120 hours of training will be reimbursed. In case of women trainees, 100% fees will be reimbursed with the intention of increasing their participation in this sector. Other assistance related to quality certification, patent, R&D will also be provided under this policy.

Another salient feature of the policy is its focus on technology and quality enhancement of logistic services. Specific support will be given to private companies to adopt disruptive technologies to increase their efficiency and visibility across the value chain including improved tracking of cargo. This will improve the quality of services and will benefit the end user immensely. Greater efficiency in the logistics network will also reduce the overall cost for the end user.

Officials also mentioned that transport is looked as a key contributor to CO2 emissions. Any policy should thus focus on decarbonizing this sector. Gujarat's Integrated Logistics and Logistics Park policy addresses this concern by extending support to R&D and innovation to make this sector sustainable and environment friendly.

A statewide logistics masterplan will be developed as part of this policy which will study the utilization of the existing infrastructure and accordingly identify strategic locations for new projects across the state. This will be done through rigorous coordination with over 10 government departments and agencies such as Ports & Transport department, Roads & Buildings department, GUJSAIL, G-Ride, GIDC, GMB, etc.

Considering it a game changer, it is learnt that a separate team of experts will be constituted to implement the objectives of this policy and promote its widespread adoption. These experts will also coordinate with private players and trade associations to identify new initiatives that can be undertaken to make Gujarat a leader in the logistics sector.



Need to look at leveraging the Anti-China sentiment: FIEO

NEW DELHI: The second Covid wave has left the economy in tatters. Amid all the gloomy news, the country's exports seem to have done well.

At the moment, the growth is looking spectacular. But it is on a very low base. We have to keep in mind that we were under lockdown because of the second wave of Covid from the second half of March to May this year. Therefore, these figures might look very impressive, but it is best not to draw conclusions from that. According to the data available with the government in May, India's exports reached \$50.7 billion during the first seven weeks of the fiscal year, 11% higher than the corresponding period in 2019-20, said FIEO CEO Ajay Sahai recently. A double-digit growth at this point is a good sign for Indian exports, considering that some states are still in the lockdown mode. We have done remarkably well in some labour-intensive sectors. Compared with 2019, the export figures are encouraging in 2020, particularly in the agriculture and processed food sectors. The latter has done very well as China's exports in this category

have taken an enormous hit. After Covid, countries are reluctant to import edible products from China. India can take its place. It is a good opportunity, but we still have a long way to go.

There will be competition from other countries, but if we focus on the processed food sector, we can make a difference. The PLI (production-linked incentive) scheme for this sector has helped India in a huge way. We are wasting around 30% of fruits and vegetables. This can change if we bring proper technology into this sector through FDI (foreign direct investment). The added advantage is that you get a new market to sell your products. So, it's a win-win situation for both the countries. I'm very bullish about the PLI scheme in the food processing sector.

On commodity prices soaring, he opined, the soaring prices have resulted in around 10% growth in exports. We have done particularly well in exports of iron and steel, copper and various other metals. The same goes for cereals as well. But it's a very delicate situation. On the one hand, we see exports booming, on the other, it creates problems for the downstream processor

because high steel prices have hit the engineering sector. We should have a strategy where we can focus on value-added exports and attract investment. A medium-to-long-term process is required here.

As an immediate step, we need to look into what we can do to encourage raw material exporters to supply to the non-value added exporters. There are many cases where the same product is being exported and imported to and from India by different units. In this process, we are not only putting pressure on the logistics sector, which is facing its own challenges, but we are unnecessarily spending foreign exchange in freight, both ways. A change in the policy will help us address that.

I take little satisfaction from the export of raw material scenario at present. I understand that exporting raw material is needed, otherwise it will suppress prices in the domestic market, but if we go overboard, then it will create a problem. A competitor in another country can get the raw material and if they have economies of scale, they can produce the final product at a much more competitive price and then beat us in the third market.

Need to raise MSMEs' share in India's Exports : Nitin Gadkari

MUMBAI: Despite the pandemic-induced slowdown, Indian merchandise exports have been growing well, to an all-time monthly high of \$32.27 billion in May, showing broad-based recovery from last year.

Small businesses are a mainstay of this performance, accounting for around half the country's merchandise exports. Commerce Secretary Anup Wadhawan has pegged merchandise exports to cross the targeted \$400 billion this year. Going forward, to achieve the Prime Minister's goal of a \$5 trillion economy, Indian exports (merchandise and services) would have to increase from \$526.55 billion in FY 19-20 to about \$1 trillion.

With that target in mind, the current contribution of the MSME sector to merchandise exports would have to at least double from \$150 billion to \$300 billion. In addition, Nitin Gadkari, the minister for MSME, has time and again highlighted that MSMEs are poised to increase their contribution to India's merchandise export to 60 percent over the next couple of years.

As we target Indian exports to increase, along with a higher share for MSMEs, it would be prudent to evaluate the preparedness of MSMEs on multiple dimensions. This exercise is even more crucial now as we await India's new Foreign Trade Policy 2021-26 slated for release in the next couple of months.

The upcoming policy is expected to be aligned to achieving the goal of a \$5 trillion economy, and the 2019 report of the High-Level Advisory Group (HLAG) on trade had a number of proposals including strengthening EXIM Bank credit, using data analytics for an export strategy, optimise FTA (Foreign Trade Agreements) negotiations and usage, increase investments in infrastructure, especially ports, reduce logistics costs, etc.

The current Foreign Trade Policy 2015-20 mentions MSMEs only twice over its extensive 164 pages. Given the significant role of MSMEs in achieving these macro goals, it would be fair to expect more detailed attention given to MSMEs in the upcoming

Foreign Trade Policy. What impacts MSME exporters the most is lack of awareness and knowledge of government schemes and international export/import standards, inadequate understanding of processes and documentation, low garnering of export credit, lack of access to markets. These have also been highlighted in the report by the HLAG on trade, along with its recommendations.

However, the effectiveness of policy lies in its implementation. Though the extant policies cover various areas affecting MSMEs, the 'implementation to intent' ratio is very small and leaves much more to be desired. One of the primary reasons for unsatisfactory implementation is inadequate State capacity. For a department that is expected to look after and promote more than 60 million MSMEs, there are not more than 500 employees to do so, which is terribly inadequate.

This bandwidth needs tactful expansion. One established option to do so is to use industry associations all over India that are used to interacting with both the government and the industry, especially MSMEs. Some of these industry associations are already authorised to issue some export documents for exporters.

Industry associations also conduct various programmes to educate the aspiring and existing exporters. The bandwidth of these industry associations can be utilised to increase the breadth and depth of engagement with exporters. The much-awaited Foreign Trade Policy 2021-26 should ensure maximising this collaboration.

Further, our embassies and trade commissions abroad are also in dire need of increased capacity. Each of these bodies have a limited bandwidth of not more than two officers who look after the trade division, while some countries such as the United Kingdom and Germany deploy dozens or even hundreds of employees in their trade and investment divisions in various countries, including India. The strength in India's missions in strategic partners must be increased substantially to promote Indian businesses and trade in those countries.

Four Trends shaping future of Pharmaceutical & Healthcare Supply Chain in India, in the backdrop of the pandemic

MUMBAI: While the Indian Pharmaceutical and Healthcare supply chain sector had been on the path of steady growth, it remained largely fragmented and motivated by the traditional growth drivers like manufacturing and import/ export. The pandemic, however, has suddenly brought the sector under spotlight, with increased demand for life saving medicines, need for blood and plasma transfusion, surgical kits and temperature sensitive vaccines. Since March 2020, the Indian pharma and healthcare supply chain has been one of the most reliable pillar for the fight against the pandemic, and continues to play a significant role in combating the virus.

As per a report by JLL, the national cold chain sector is expected to grow at over 20% CAGR by 2025, and the Indian Pharmaceutical and healthcare supply chain remains a major growth driver. The pandemic has led to accelerated transformation of the sector and has opened up immense opportunity for expansion in not only Tier-I cities but also in Tier-II cities and towns.

Some of the key trends that are shaping the future of this sector, can be highlighted as under:

1. Tech Adoption: This has been the cornerstone of change and disruption, transforming logistics and supply chains sector as a whole. From automation in warehousing for monitoring and maintaining cold storage facilities to driverless vehicles, and use of AI and ML enabled processes to ensure efficacy and speed, the Indian logistics sector has been rapidly adopting to change.

2. Enhanced reach: Empowered by the policy push for infrastructure development in logistics, the Indian pharma and healthcare supply chain is further expanding its reach. Tech adoption, newer rail and road transport routes, setting up of dedicated logistic parks around ports etc., has given rise to the development of multi-modal logistics, and ensured that the vaccines and vital medicines are made accessible to the remotest corner of the country, in a shorter turn around time.

3. Skilled and trained manpower: Tech adoption has put the need for training and up-skilling of handling staff and labourers, under spotlight. Given the significance of the cargo, especially sensitive medical material, like medicines,

diagnostics kits and temperature sensitive vaccines, educating and training warehouse, transport and ground handling staff to handle the shipments with efficiency, has become vital. The training and up-skilling of labourers in Logistics and warehousing had been a largely ignored area so far. However, the pandemic has highlighted the urgent need and accelerated the process of adopting regular training for both, on ground and managerial staff, about effective handling of life-saving cargo, optimising tech enabled warehouse and supply chain operations and focusing on digital literacy for the blue collar staff.

4. Policy push for FDI: The government decision of conferring infrastructure status to logistics has been one of the most important impetus for growth of the pharma and healthcare supply chain in the recent times. Apart from a lot of other benefits, this move has enabled the sector to be eligible for 100% foreign direct investment (FDI), especially in the storage and warehousing sector. This has been instrumental in allowing businesses to gain access to the much needed funds for accelerated tech adoption and expansion, at lower rates, and longer tenures. This is also enabling companies in the logistics and warehousing sector to access large sums under the external commercial borrowing (ECB), at a lower cost and longer tenure.

While all of the above factors are key drivers for growth of the sector, largely brought about due to the global pandemic, the renewed push for manufacturing and vocal for local initiatives are going further to ensure there is a continuous impetus for growth, in the post COVID era.

Drewry's World Container Index experiences its steepest ever climb

LONDON: Shippers hoping for some pricing respite from ocean carriers have been battered this week by further records falling. Drewry's World Container Index, published recently, saw its steepest climb since its inception in 2012.

Drewry's composite World Container index rose a further 15.9% or \$1,104 to reach \$8,061.65 per FEU, which is 332% higher than the same week in 2020.

Rates from Shanghai to Los Angeles increased by more than a third in the space of week, from \$6,358 per FEU last week to \$8,548 this week. Rates from Asia to US east coast also soared 39% to \$11,180 per FEU.

Spot rates on Shanghai-Genoa increased \$603 to stand at \$11,448 for a 40ft box, which is 540% higher than same period in 2020. Similarly, rates on Shanghai-Rotterdam gained \$779 to reach \$11,975, a year-on-year change of 626%.

"Drewry expects rates to remain on the higher side in the coming week," the UK analysts stated.

Meanwhile, the Shanghai Containerized Freight Index (SCFI) climbed another 37 points recently to a new record of 3,785.

Commenting via LinkedIn on the latest record-breaking box figures, Lars Jensen, CEO of consultancy Vespucci Maritime, stated: "I would expect upwards pressure on essentially all headhaul trades."

DGFT notifies pact regarding import of 50,000 tonnes of toor dal from Malawi

NEW DELHI: The commerce ministry's arm DGFT has notified an MoU regarding import of 50,000 tonnes of toor dal (pigeon peas) from Malawi, a landlocked nation in the southeastern Africa. The directorate general of foreign trade (DGFT) in a public notice said that India will provide an annual quota of 50,000 tonnes of toor dal to be imported from Malawi, through private trade over the next five financial years -- 2021-22 to 2025-26 (April to March).

"Import of 50,000 tonnes of toor from Malawi during 2021-22 to 2025-26 as per the MoU entered between Government of India and the Government of Malawi is notified," the DGFT said.

In another public notice, the DGFT has also notified import of 2,50,000 tonnes of urad and 1,00,000 tonnes of toor from Myanmar during 2021-22 to 2025-26 as per an MoU entered between the two countries.

Forex reserves decline \$4 bn to \$603.93 bn on slide in Gold assets

MUMBAI: Sliding from a lifetime high, the country's foreign exchange reserves declined by \$4.148 billion to reach \$603.933 billion for the week ended 18 June due to a fall in gold and currency assets, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) data showed.

The forex kitty had surged by \$3.074 billion to a record high of \$608.081 billion in the previous reporting week.

According to the data by the RBI, the foreign currency assets

(FCA), a major component of the overall reserves, declined by \$1.918 billion to \$561.540 billion for the reporting week.

After a \$490 million rise in the previous week, the gold reserves declined by \$2.170 billion to \$35.931 billion, the RBI data showed.

The special drawing rights (SDRs) with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) dipped by \$14 million to \$1.499 billion.

MSC added Services & Equipment to ease Supply Chain Crunch : CEO

MSC CEO speaks at World Ports Conference in Antwerp



GENEVA: MSC has been continuously investing to help manage the unprecedented impact on supply chains of the COVID pandemic and port congestion problems, CEO Soren Toft told the IAPH World Ports Conference in a keynote interview on the Essential Role of Container Shipping & Logistics, in which he defended the role of carriers in global trade.

"The supply chain has been under amazing pressure and there are a number of factors contributing to it," Soren said, speaking in Antwerp, Belgium, on 23 June. "Our company, our industry, has really demonstrated that we could keep supply chains moving despite all the issues."

MSC has started 8 new services in the past few months, deployed available vessel capacity and provided hundreds of thousands of additional containers to help respond to the huge demand for cargo transportation in an extremely challenging and congested market. Unpredicted wild swings in demand, labour shortages at ports and across trucking networks, as well as a legacy of underinvestment in older port complexes have all contributed to the malaise in the market since Q3 2020.

That situation was compounded by the week-long Suez Canal closure in late March and suspension of activities at port terminals in Yantian, South China in May and June, leaving delegates at the World Ports Conference wondering throughout the week-long digital event how port providers could improve resilience and collaboration during times of market disruption.

Soren said MSC was very focused on minimising supply chain disruption, even if shipping and logistics companies are not the cause of the dislocation in the container market.

"We are continuing to expand our footprint to really meet the demands of our customers," he said. "I realise from a service reliability point of view we must do better. It is also in our interests, because today we are consuming way too much fuel, we have too many ships in the networks, too many containers, all as a result of supply chains being stretched."

Decarbonisation: actions vs aspirational targets

Despite the comprehensive use of fuel and assets, and a waiting game outside congested ports that has seen MSC suffer around 10,000 days-equivalent of lost sailing time, the



company has continued to focus on improving energy efficiency in its fleet of over 600 ships. Better access to port infrastructure for larger, more energy-efficient ships and coordination by ports for standardised shore power plug connections are among the interim measures which would help carriers to keep on improving efficiency, Soren said.

The shipping industry is intensifying its focus on the essential task of decarbonisation. A global approach to policy making and regulation and a worldwide R&D fund, which could amount to \$5 billion, or even \$10 billion, will be crucial to catalyse the process. Meanwhile, collaboration with energy companies, engine manufacturers and other shipping companies is also key to unlocking the handful of alternative fuels that must be developed urgently at scale.

"When those fuels are there, MSC will also transition to those fuels as quickly as fast as we can," Soren said. "Our focus is on decarbonising the world, less on identifying a target."

Digitalisation: customer needs

Referring to another key trends of the coming years, Soren – whose keynote followed an earlier interview with MSC Chief Digital & Information Officer Andre Simha on the worldwide deployment of the eBill of Lading – also referred to the key topic of digitalisation as a major "mission" that will shape the future of the container shipping industry.

Digitising processes to improve operational efficiency and enhancing digital channels to propose new solutions to customers will help to ensure that MSC will continue to be "in continuous evolution" for the years to come, Soren said.
